Treasurers Report

Membership numbers grew 5% this year to 785 (747 in 2024).

Total race entries fell 11% this season to 703 (793 in 2024), coinciding with a Fastet year.

The level of Sponsorship is similar to 2023. We are very grateful for the ongoing support of our sponsors.

Catherine Platts has been a welcome addition to the team this year.

We continue to see rising costs on overheads, including the introduction of Bank Service Fees. Nevertheless we managed to control expenditure in other areas, such as the race expenses & photography to ensure we acheived a modest surplus.

The Club become liable for Corporation Tax on the interest and has paid the 2024/25 liability.

The club achieved an operating surplus of £1,807 increasing the Undesignated Funds to £30,843 with a further £76,917 held as reserves in a 95-day deposit or fixed term account.

Generation JOG ran a weekend training event which was well attended. Total funds raised was £4,362 (including donations via race entries) less costs of £4,985. The fund balance is reduced to £1,424 which is carried forward. See Note 1 for full details.
